

# GOA LABOUR WELFARE BOARD

## SCHEME – III

### SCHEME FOR AWARD OF SCHOLARSHIPS TO SCHOOL OR COLLEGE GOING CHILDREN OF EMPLOYEES / INDUSTRIAL EMPLOYEES IN VARIOUS ESTABLISHMENTS.

1. Scholarships shall be awarded to school or College going children of a worker employed in establishments covered under the Goa, Daman & Diu Labour Welfare Fund Act, 1986 provided that:
  - i) He / She is a regular worker (having not less than six (6) months continuous service) employed in the Industrial Establishment performing any skilled or unskilled, manual or clerical labour, otherwise than in a position of supervision or management.
  - ii) His / her total income from the salary does not exceed Rs. 20,000/- (Rupees twenty thousand only) per month including all allowances and perks but exclusive of bonus.

2. Scholarships shall be awarded at the following rates per student per year.

**Group I**

Class V & VI

Rs. 2000/-

**Group II**

Class VII, VIII, IX & X

Rs. 2800/-

**Group III**

Class XI, XII, XIII, UAI SC Etc

Rs. 3600/

**(All pre-graduation course where admission is open for students after Qualifying in X<sup>th</sup> Class).**

**Group IV**

Graduation and post Graduation Degree Courses in Arts, Science, & Commerce and Lower Technical like B.T., L.T., B.ED., M.ED., & L.L.B., Etc.

Rs. 10,000/

**Group V**

M.B.B.S., B.E., B.SC. (Agri.) and other Higher Technical courses, Research and Doctorate Studies.

Rs. 20,000/

3. The total number of scholarships to be awarded in each academic year for each group of classes as defined in regulation No. 2 above will be fixed suitably by the Secretary of the Board in consultation with the Advisory Committee of the Board subject to the availability of funds in the sanctioned budget.

**Provided that:**

The total number of scholarships to be awarded in an academic year in the State for each group of classes should not exceed by more than 10% of the number of such scholarships awarded during the previous academic year.

4. Ten percent of the total number of scholarships fixed for each group shall be reserved for the children of the 'Lower Category' Notwithstanding, anything contained in Regulation No. 1 'Lower Category' shall mean and include:
  - i) Children of those workers whose income from all sources do not exceed Rs. 3,500/- (Rupees three thousand five hundred only) per month.

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- ii) Children belonging to Other Backward Communities.
- iii) Physically handicapped children.

5. Candidates for the award of scholarships should have taken admission for studies at recognized institutions in India in any course of general or technical education including medical, engineering and agricultural studies. However, the following category of students are not eligible for scholarships under scheme:

- i) Students who, after passing one stage of education are studying in the same stage of education in a different subject e.g. 1 S.C., after I.A. or B.Com. after B.A. or M.A. in one subject after M.A. in another subject.
- ii) Students who after having completed their education career in one professional line continue education in a different professional line e.g. L.L.B. after B.T. or B.Ed.

**Note:** Students who are pursuing research work or higher learning in the same professional or academic line shall be eligible for the scholarship i.e. Ph. D. or M. Phi. after completing P.G. Courses, M. D. Or M.S. after M.B.B.S.

6. The primary consideration for awarding scholarships shall be the merit of the student. The following students only are eligible for consideration.

- i) Students belonging to Lower Category as defined in Regulation No. 4 should have been qualified for promotion in the last annual examination.
- ii) Students who do not belong to 'Lower Category' should have qualified for promotion in the last annual examination with 45% or more marks in the aggregate

7. Application for the scholarship shall made in the prescribed form and should be sent to the Secretary through the Heads of the Institutions where the student is studying.

8. Each application for scholarship should be endorsed by a Certificate as in Part – II from the Manager, Agent or owner of the Industrial Establishment concerned declaring that the applicant is son / daughter of an employee of the Industrial establishment of the Category specified in Regulation 1 and testifying the income of his / her parent. If both the parents are employed in Industrial Establishment, two such certificates are require to be sent alongwith the application form.

9. The last date of submission of application to the Secretary is the 30<sup>th</sup> of September, each year.

10. The scholarship amount shall be paid by the Secretary in one instalment through ECS facility in parents bank account .

11. Students who receive scholarship or stipend from any other source will be granted a scholarship to the extent the fund's scholarship exceeds the other scholarship or stipend.

12. The scholarship sanctioned is liable to be cancelled on the following occasions,

- i) If the scholar is found to have obtained a scholarship by false statements.
- ii) If the scholar discontinued his / her studies, the scholarship shall be stopped from the date of such discontinuance.

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- iii) If the scholar changes the subject of the course of study for which scholarship was originally awarded or changes the Institution of study without the prior approval of the Secretary.
- iv) If the scholar fails to make satisfactory progress in the studies or is irregular in attendance or is guilty of misconduct during the academic year for which scholarships has been granted.
- v) If the parent (s) of the scholar ceases to be the employee of the Industrial Establishment.

**Note:-** If the scholar is found to have committed any one or more of the above after the scholarship amount has been actually been paid to him / her, the amount shall be recovered forthwith from him / her or his/her parents
