DEATH BENEFIT

The Board may sanction an amount of fifty thousand rupees to the nominees/dependents of a member towards death benefit, in case of natural death. If the death is due to an accident, during the course of employment the nominees/dependents of the members shall be given One Lakh rupees towards death benefit.

Application for death benefit. -

- (1) A nominee who is entitled to death benefit under this rule shall submit to the Secretary or any other officer authorized by him an application in Form No. XXXVII. A certificate regarding the death/accident death issued by a Government doctor not below the rank of an Assistant Surgeon shall be produced along with the application and other documents specified by the Board.
- (2) The Secretary or the Officer authorised by him may, on receipt of the application, conduct an enquiry with regard to the eligibility of the applicant.
- (3) If the Secretary or the officer authorized by him is satisfied that the person who has applied for financial assistance is entitled for such benefit he may sanction the amount.
- (4) The sanctioning authority shall maintain a register for this purpose in Form No. XXXVIII.
- (5) A person aggrieved by any decision taken under sub-rule (3) may file an appeal before the Board within sixty days from the date of receipt of the order under that sub-rule and the decision of the Board thereon shall be final
